Villain of the Month for August 2003 Beatrice Roberts

Beatrice Roberts is one of many actresses who made a big impression on serial goers of the late thirties but never really had a good role outside of the weekly chapter plays. The early part of her career had her star in such low budget films as Love Takes Flight (1937), Bill Cracks Down (1937), and The Devil's Party (1938).

Her big serial was playing the evil Queen Azura in Universal's Flash Gordon's Trip to Mars (1938). Her character was helping Ming terrorize the Earth while also waging a war on the Clay People of her own



planet. After this serial Roberts had only one more starring role in the B Western Pioneers of the West (1940).

The rest of Roberts career was appearing in small roles in A and B pictures. Among her film credits are the horror films Frankenstein Meets the Wolf Man (1942) and The Phantom of the Opera (1943) remake. She popped up in the mysteries Mystery of Marie Roget (1942), Dead Man's Eyes (1944), and the noir classic The Killers (1946). Other films credits include The Egg and I (1947), Mr. Peabody and the Mermaid (1948), and Deana Durbin's final romantic comedy For the Love of Mary (1948).
